Seventeen-year-old Asha was unjustly imprisoned, gang-raped and forced to watch friends and family brutally murdered in her African homeland. Now she is in Hong Kong, and proper legal assistance can help her win asylum protection from the United Nations and eventual resettlement in a safe country.

The Hong Kong Refugee Advice Centre Ltd. (“HKRAC”) is a registered charitable institution. HKRAC is the only dedicated provider of *pro bono* legal assistance to refugees seeking asylum protection at the Hong Kong office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees. While HKRAC is a relatively young organization, we have accomplished many of our goals in a short period of time.

- HKRAC has helped over 240+ refugees. We have represented over 50 different ethnicities and speakers of 37 different languages.
- HKRAC has partnered with five international law firms who have dedicated funding and thousands of *pro bono* hours each month to advise and represent our refugee clients to the highest ethical standard.
- HKRAC hosts three comprehensive weekend training sessions annually. To date, we have trained approximately 120 volunteer caseworkers and interpreters.
- Commencing in 2009, HKRAC is launching programs for competitively selected students at the Law Faculties of both the University of Hong Kong and the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
- HKRAC has established an international presence, serving on the Steering Committee of the Asia Pacific Refugee Rights Network (APRRN) and as a founding member of the East Asia Sub-Regional Refugee Rights Network.
- HKRAC has maintained superior professional standards by focusing on quality legal assistance and uncompromising ethics in our casework.
